- Let you know if there are any concerns or problems that affect your child's work or behaviour and any reasons for celebration.
- Keep you informed about school matters in general.
- Have an open and welcoming ethos with opportunities for scheduled involvement and participation in the day to day life of the school.
- Treat any concerns expressed by parents or guardians seriously, investigate thoroughly and keep parents / guardians informed.
- Inform you in advance about what the teacher expects to teach your child each term.
- Treat all children and parents fairly, professionally and without discrimination.
- Make you aware of the role and keep you updated of the work of the Cherry Tree Governing Board.

AS PARENTS / CARERS / GUARDIANS I/WE WILL:

- Ensure that my child comes to school regularly and punctually and provide a note of explanation if the child is absent for any reason.
- Let the school know immediately about any concerns or issues that might affect the work or behaviour of my child.
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about my child's progress.

- Be aware of and support the school's ethos, vision and policies. (The vision and ethos is outlined in the New Intake Pack, in the letter from Mrs Graham. Any relevant policies can be found on our school website.)
- Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- Read regular newsletters.
- Ensure that my child wears the correct uniform and is equipped to participate in the full range of school activities.
- Ensure that the school always has up to date telephone numbers in case of emergency.
- As a parent/carer, I agree to support the work and undertaking of the school.
- As a parent/carer, I will encourage my child/children to use age-appropriate social media sites in a responsible manner.
- As a parent/carer, I or my family members will not post pictures, photographs, images of any children on any internet sites without parental permission.
