

We are passionate about providing children with a range of opportunities beyond the classroom – some within our local community and others further afield.

Our enrichment and outreach opportunities are designed to stimulate interest, inspire and motivate our children and to develop their individual talents. Our KS2 classes participate in two contrasting residential visits that complement the curriculum and offer and develop personal growth, confidence and self-esteem.

All children have the opportunity to be involved in inter and intra- school sports events as well as engaging with high quality arts experiences such as participation in specialist music lessons, live performance and art exhibitions.

In addition, we have an extensive range of extra-curricular activities on offer each term such as netball, football, karate, fencing, singing, French, Spanish, drama etc. Club lists are published at the start of each term.
